Dul Chun Cinn ó Thús na Bliana *Developments Since the Start of the Year.*

Tá béim curtha againn ar na nithe seo ó thús na bliana ar scoil. Aithníodh na pointí thíos tar éis athbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar an scoil mar pháirt d'ár bhféinmheasadóireacht scoile ó anuraidh.

Gaeilge labhartha ar scoil agus ag am súgartha: Faigheann páiste i ngach rang corn gach seachtain don iarracht is fearr do labhairt na gaeilge. Córas cártaí do ranganna 3-6 agus mírlíne do NB-R2 chun dea-nósanna a spreagadh. Páistí na Míosa fós ag dul ar aghaidh.

Léitheoireacht: Tá infheistíocht mór déanta ag an scoil ar leabhair léitheoireacht i nGaeilge agus i mBéarla. Bíonn siad ag dul abhaile mar thacaíocht do pháistí lena léitheoireacht.

Teicneolaíocht: Tá taibléidí faighte ag an scoil do Ranganna 3&4 mar achmhainn tacaíochta don bhfoghlaim. Tá súil againn cur leo do ranganna eile amach anseo. Táimid i gcónaí ag lorg tacaíocht maidir le maoiniú a fháil. Má tá suim agat cabhrú linn bí i dteagmháil leis an oifig nó le Seán.

The school has identified the following areas for improvement as part of our school self-evaluation process over the last year:

Spoken Irish in School & During Play: We continue to implement schemes to improve the speaking of Irish in school. We award pupils on a weekly and monthly basis for their efforts. Also we have introduced an individual card system from R3-6 and a collective marble system for NB-R2 that rewards effort.

Reading: The school has made a significant investment in reading books for both Gaeilge & Béarla. They are being sent home with classes as part of their homework and to help develop fluency.

Technology: As well as our continued upgrading of our classrooms, the school has obtained a suite of tablets for use by Rang 3 & 4. We are hoping to add to them in the future. If you can help us in any way, please make contact with the school and arrange to speak with Seán.
